Web Address:

also called a Uniform Resource Locator (URL) and is made up of several parts

http://

stands for Hypertext Transfer Protocol, the set of rules for exchanging information on the Web

Domain name:

the unique name that identifies an Internet site

• Program Basics

To Open a Web Page:

Click the Address Bar, type in the address of the Web page

To Open a Hyperlink:

Click the hyperlink on the Web page

To Open a Hyperlink in a New Tab:

Press and hold the Ctrl key and click the hyperlink on the Web page

To Refresh a Web page:

Click Refresh button on the Address Bar

To Stop Downloading a Page:

Click Stop button on the Address Bar

To Go Back to a Page:

Click the Back button

To Go Forward a Page:

Click the Forward button



To Print a Web Page:

Click the Print button on the Command Bar or press Ctrl + P

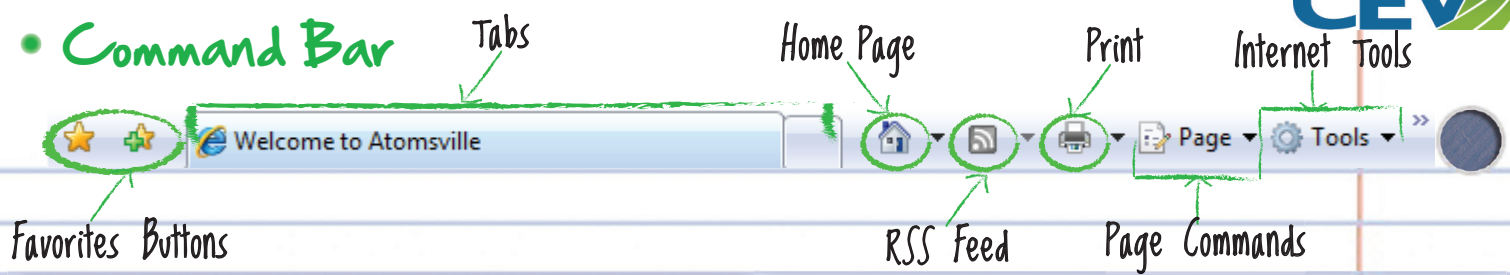
To Print Preview:

Click the Print button list arrow on the Command Bar and select Print Preview from the list

Keyboard Shortcuts

Ctrl + F	Find
Ctrl + N	Open New Window
Ctrl + P	Print a Web Page
Ctrl + T	Open New Tab
Ctrl + W	Close Tab or Window
F 11	Full Screen Mode
F 1	Help
F 5	Refresh page

• Command Bar



Home Pages & the Command Bar:

- To Go to the Home Page:
Click the Home Page button on the Command Bar or press Ctrl + M
- To Add or Change a Home Page:
Click the Home Page button list arrow and select Add or Change Home Page
- To Remove a Home Page:
Click the Home Page button list arrow, point to Remove, select the page you want to remove and click Yes

Using the Command Bar:

- To Increase Text Size:
Click the Tools button on the Command Bar, point to Text Size and select a Text size from the list
- To View Browsing History:
Click the Favorites Center button and click the History button
- To Delete Browsing History:
Click the Tools button on the Command Bar and select Delete Browsing History

• Favorites

- To View and Open Favorites:
Click the Favorites Center button and click the Favorites button
- To Add a Favorite:
Open the page you want to add as a favorite, click the Add to Favorites button

• RSS Feeds

- To Subscribe to an RSS Feed:
Open the page from which you want to access feeds, click the View feeds on this page button
- To View RSS Feed:
Click the Favorites Center button and click the View Feeds Button
